



## Post Operative Instructions

### EYELID REDUCTION

1. Sleep on 2 or 3 pillows to keep the head elevated. This will reduce swelling.
2. Moisten gauze with saline and place on your eyelids as tolerated. This is soothing and reduces discomfort.
3. **If there is severe pain or visual impairment contact us immediately** – this would be an extremely unlikely occurrence.

For lubrication of the eyes:

**Day:** "Tears Plus" (optional)

**Night:** "Visco-Tears Gel"

Should you experience any difficulty looking after the wound or there are problems with the wound itself, please contact Dr. Knox's office on 9553 9188.

<b>Medication</b>	<b>Possible Adverse Reaction</b>
Tears Plus	Stinging and burning
Visco-Tears Gel	Mild transient burning, sticky eyelids, blurred vision
